Before installation:

our fender eliminator have been designed for modification purposes, we are not responsible for the use or misuse of any products, or verification of the local department of motor vehicles.

Included in the kit:

- 1 Fender Eliminator Bracket
- 4 Signal mounting plates
- 1 Licence plate light
- 2 Licence plate screws + nuts
- 4 Flenge bolts
- 4 Locknuts



Instructions:

1. Remove front and rear seat.
2. Gently take off the tail section part (this operation will give you access to wirings)
3. Unplug both signals and license plate light (locate the connectors on the left side)
4. Remove the rear mud-guard (lower part)
5. Remove the stock signals rubber grommet.
6. Mount the license plate light to your new fender eliminator.
7. Put in place your new fender eliminator, holes should align with the higher stock mud guard section.
- 8a. **INSTALLATION WITH OEM SIGNALS.** If you are planning to re-install the stock signals you wont need the 4 flenge bolts/4lock nuts, use signal plate adapters and reconnect the signals.
- 8b. **INSTALLATION WITH AFTERMARKET SIGNALS.** Use the plate adapters provided in the kit, install your new signals, by using 1 flenge bolt and lock nut you will fill the extra hole, connect your new signals.
- 8c. **INSTALLATION WITHOUT SIGNALS.** Use the plate adapters provided in the kit, install them with the 2 flenge bolt and lock nuts to hold everything & to fill holes.
9. Connect your license plate light by driving the wires through the original passage, we suggest to not cut the connectors on the bike, just splice behind connectors, that will do the job.
