- 1x Plate light CY25760
- 2x Allen bolt M6 FA27961
- 4x Lock nut Zinc QU27946
- 2x Nylon plate bolt/nut AU27945
- 1x Double face tape RU36558

**\*\*After any installations or modifications, the fender eliminator not returnable. We are not responsible for any damages to the part during the installation process, or to the bike (including the stock undertail part).**

- 1- Take off the seat
- 2- Remove the grey side cover on the right side (see Pic 1)
- 3- Only for the ER6N...for the Ninja 650 go to step 4, On the right side remove the grab bar with the 2 Allen key bolt. (see Pic 2)
- 4- By removing the "snap-pin" gently remove the right tail section to get access to your wiring.
- 5- Unplug signals and plate light (see Pic 3)
- 6- Remove the stock mud-guard with the 2 allen bolts (by storage) and the 2 nuts by underneath.
- 7- Keep the 2 allen bolts for re-installation.
- 8- Stick your new plate light to your new fender with the provided 3M double face tape.
- 9- With the 4 lock nuts, the 2 allen bolt provided and the 2 stock allen bolt install your new fender in place, use the 2 longest bolt (stock ones) to bolt through the undertail & sub frame and the 2 shortest ones to bolt only through the undertail. (see Pic 4)
- 10- Drive your wires for plate light & signals if you install some.
- 11- Put back tail section/Grab bar/Side cover and your seat and ...Enjoy!!!
